A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories, to declare a one-half (1/2) day civic holiday on Friday, March 20, 2026, to enjoy the Yellowknives Dene First Nation (YKDFN) Spring Carnival.

PURSUANT TO sections 4 and 70(1) of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, SNWT 2003, c.22.

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife wishes to encourage the citizens of Yellowknife to enjoy and participate in the festivities of the YKDFN Spring Carnival on Friday, March 20, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular sessions duly assembled, enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

1. This by-law may be cited as the “Yellowknives Dene First Nation 2026 Spring Carnival By-law”.
2. That the period from 12:00 noon until 5:00 p.m. (Mountain Time) on Friday, March 20, 2026 is hereby declared to be a civic holiday.

EFFECT

3. That this by-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 75 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.
