

**CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE
BY-LAW NO. 4311**

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories, to amend Highway Traffic By-law No. 4063, as amended to date.

PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 70(1) and 73 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c.C-8;

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife has enacted Highway Traffic By-law No. 4063; and

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife wishes to amend Highway Traffic By-law No. 4063 with respect to adding the reference to a parking certificate in s. 73(1) that will be issued to food vendors wishing to operate on public property in the downtown core, as s. 73(1) speaks to the issuance of parking meter exemption permits;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife wishes to a severability clause to Highway Traffic By-law No. 4063;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

1. Highway Traffic By-law No. 4063 hereby amended by:

- (a) Deleting the definition of Senior Citizen in section 2 in its entirety and replacing it with:

"Senior Citizen means a person who has attained the age of sixty years;"

- (b) Deleting section 73(1) in its entirety and replacing it with:

"The City Administrator upon application and the payment of thirty dollars per month or three

hundred dollars per year, plus applicable tax, may issue a prepaid parking certificate for a vending stand as defined in Business Licence By-law No. 3451 or any successor by-law; and a prepaid parking sticker to vehicles registered as commercial vehicles, public service vehicles and government vehicles, with such restrictions as the City Administrator deems necessary or expedient."

(c) Adding section 139 as follows:


"SEVERABILITY


139. Should any provision of this by-law be found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalid provision shall be severed and the remaining provisions of the by-law shall be maintained."

EFFECT


2. This by-law shall come into effect upon having received Third Reading and otherwise meeting the requirements of Section 75 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.


