CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE BY-LAW NO. 4447

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories, to amend Section 8 of By-law No. 4207 which governs the senior citizens and disabled persons tax relief.

PURSUANT to Section 2 and 4 of the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief Act, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c.50 (Supp.);

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular sessions duly assembled, enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

- 1. That Section 8 of By-law No. 4207 be deleted and the following be replaced therewith:
 - "Upon application, the City shall exempt the eligible property of a senior citizen or a disabled person from 50% of the taxes to a maximum of \$1,000 where:
 - a) the senior citizen or disabled person is the sole owner of the eligible property and ordinarily resides on it; or
 - b) the senior citizen or disabled person is the part owner of the eligible property, and all other part owners are senior citizens, disabled persons or dependants of the senior citizen or disabled person."

EFFECT

2. That this by-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 75 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act.
