CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE BY-LAW NO. 4520

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories, authorizing the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife to amend Zoning By-law No. 4404.

PURSUANT TO

- a) Section 25 to 29 inclusive of the *Planning Act*, R. S.N.W.T., 1988, C. P-7;
- b) Due notice to the public, provision for inspection of this by-law and due opportunity for objections thereto to be heard, considered and determined; and
- c) The approval of the Minister of Municipal and Community Affairs, certified hereunder.

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife has enacted Zoning By-law No. 4404;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife wishes to amend Zoning By-law No. 4404;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular sessions duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

- 1. That By-law No. 4404 of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, is hereby amended by:
 - Rezoning those portions of Lots 41 and 42, Block 62,
 Plan 4243 from "R1" Low Density Residential to "R3"
 Medium Density Residential.
 - b. Amending Schedule No. 1 to Zoning By-law No. 4404 in accordance with Schedule No. A-1 attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
 - c. Amending Section 10.9(4)(c) as follows:

"Notwithstanding subsections 10.9(3)(c) and (f), on Lots 19U, 41, and 42 in Block 62 (#'s 5602 and 5604

Franklin Avenue), the maximum permitted height shall be three (3) stories to a maximum of 12.5 metres and the principal building shall be set back a minimum of 7.5 metres from Lot 15, Block 62 (#4916 Matonabee Street)."

EFFECT

2. That this by-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 75 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act.
