To be the most inclusive, progressive and well-managed community in Canada.

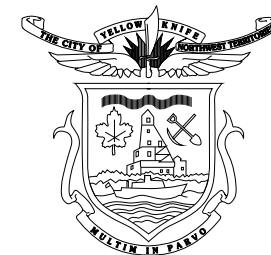
