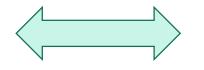

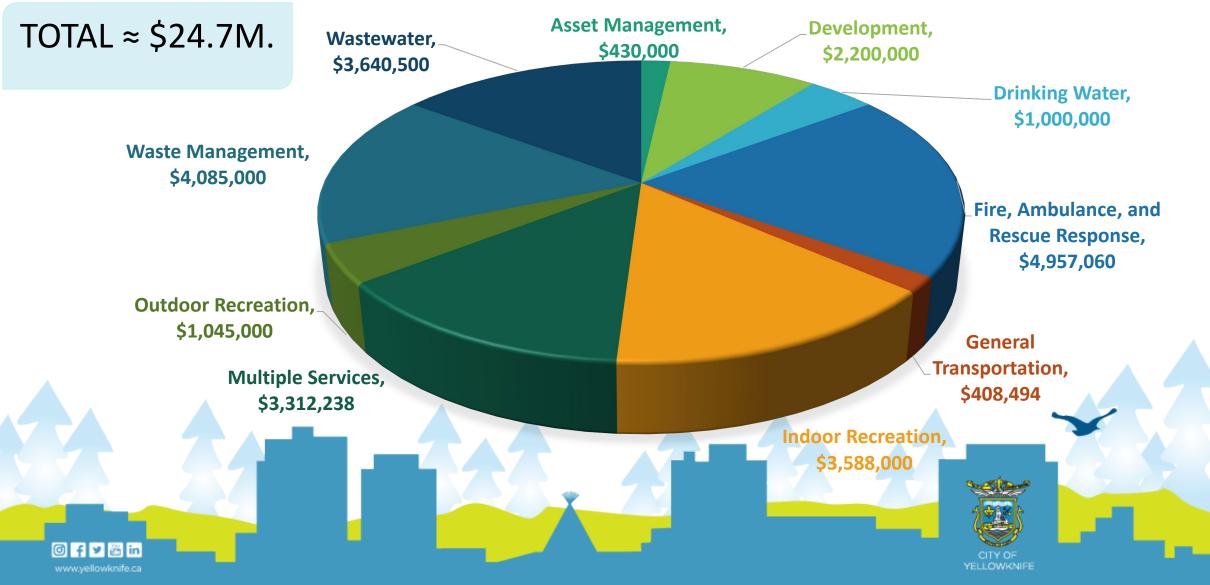

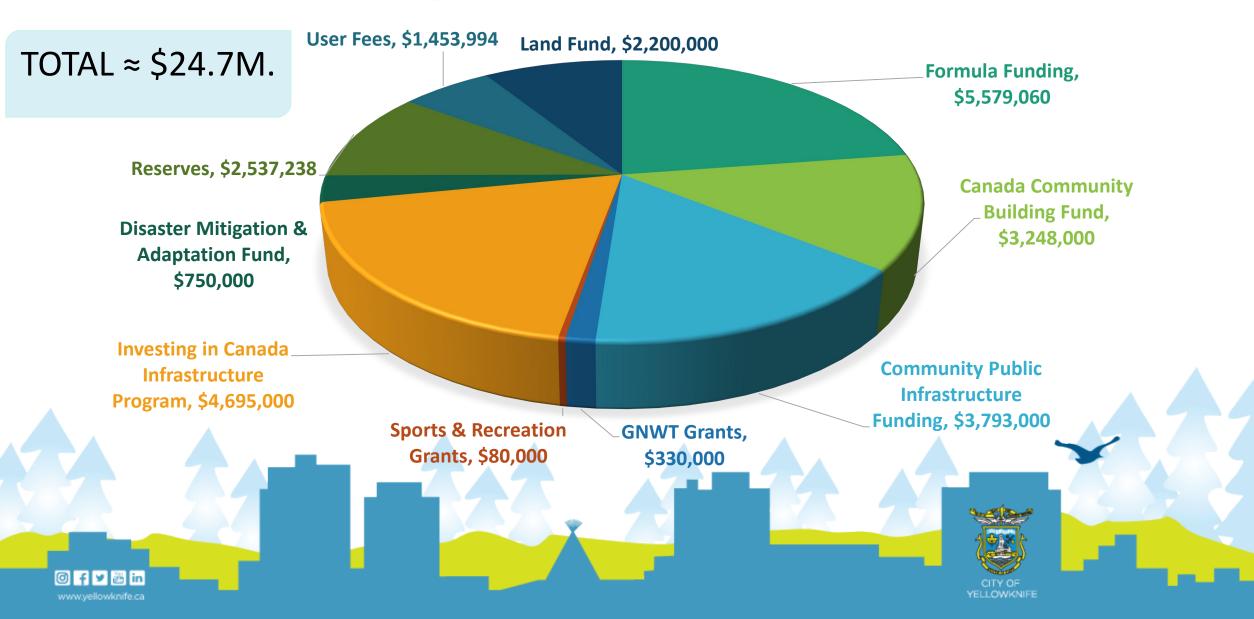
Asset Management Lens

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Budget 2024 Council Initiatives

- \$100,000 for consultancy on Area Development Plan for Kam Lake
 - \$100,000 for consultancy for Street Outreach Program
- \$100,000 for Destination Market Organization (DMO)
- \$20,000 for public education on evacuation preparedness
- \$100,000 for Wildfires After-Action Assessment Implementation

\$100,000 for Downtown clean-up program



Budget 2024 Public Input

- A Cost-Benefit Analysis on water delivery services.
- An outdoor hockey rink with permanent structures
- Increased Budget for Lake View Cemetery maintenance
- Ongoing maintenance of firebreaks and fire smarting programs
- Adequate seating at bus shelters easily accessible to all user groups
- Enhance safety of residents and businesses in downtown
- Trail between Racquet Club and Ski Club along Back Bay
- Addition of a pick up and drop off point for William McDonald School Students
- Continuation of multi-path on 52nd Ave. between 49th St. to 44th St.

Budget 2024 Public Presentations

• Makerspace YK – Allocation of \$40,000-\$50,000 towards O&M

• Yellowknife Women's Society – Allocation of \$1.1 million for YK1 outreach plus \$350,000 as initial start-up

• Folk On The Rocks Society – Loan forgiveness of \$60,000.
