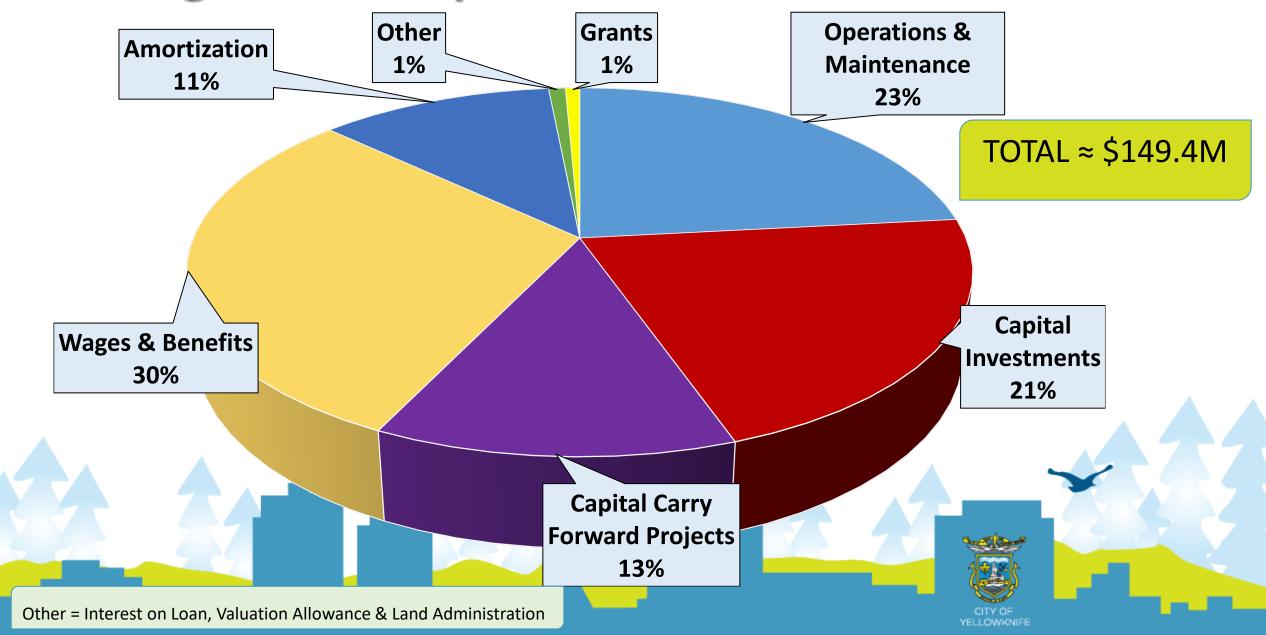
2026 Budget Context

- Rising Costs: Inflation continues to impact service delivery and capital projects.
- > Aging Infrastructure: Maintenance and upgrades are increasingly urgent
- Shrinking Land availability for Development: Constrains growth and community resilience.
- Outdated Technology: Reduced efficiency and security vulnerabilities
- > Stagnating Tax Base: Limited revenue growth while service demands are rising

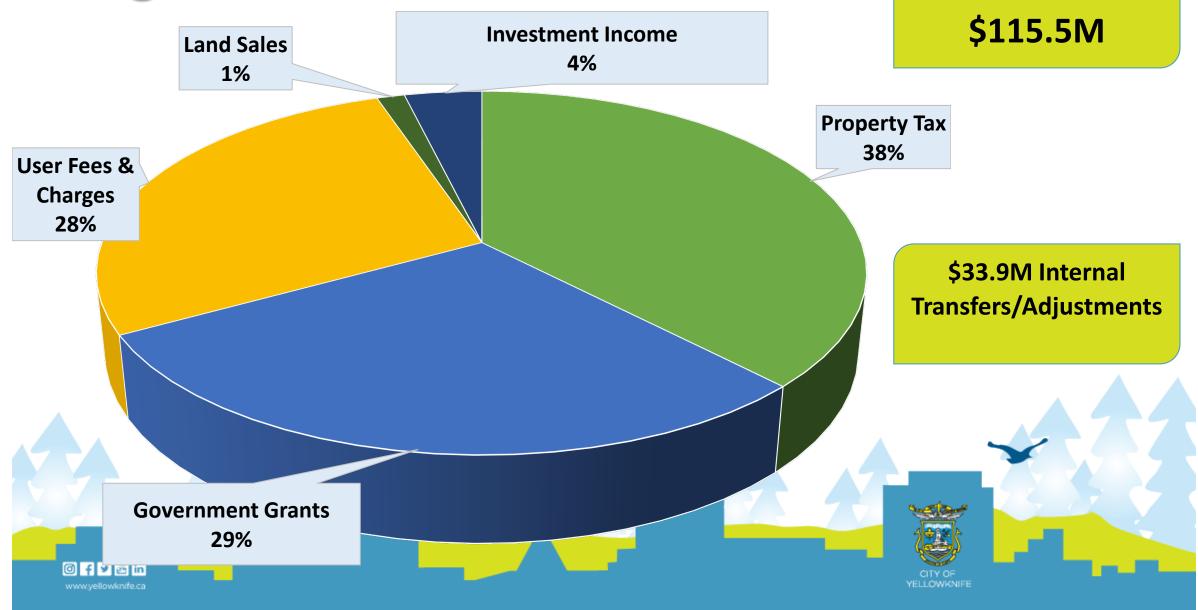




Budget 2026 Expenses

- > \$80,000 for Corporate Business Continuity Plan





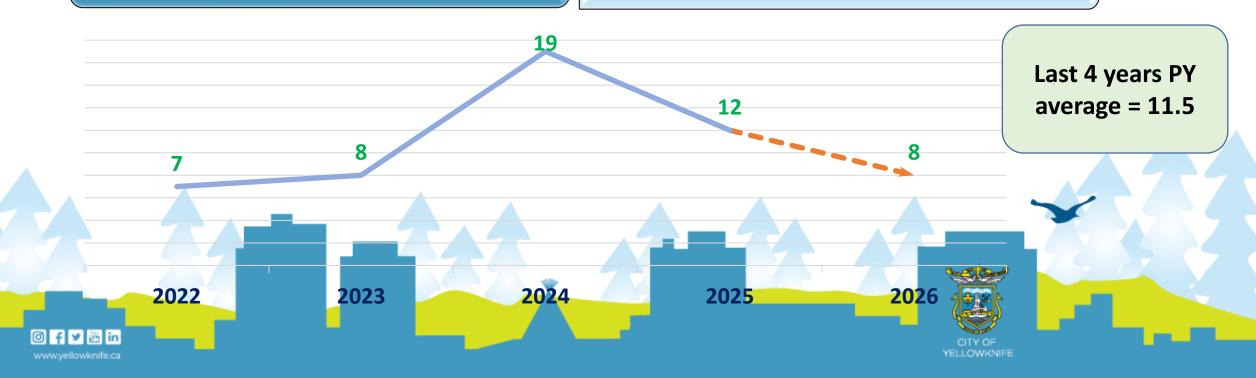

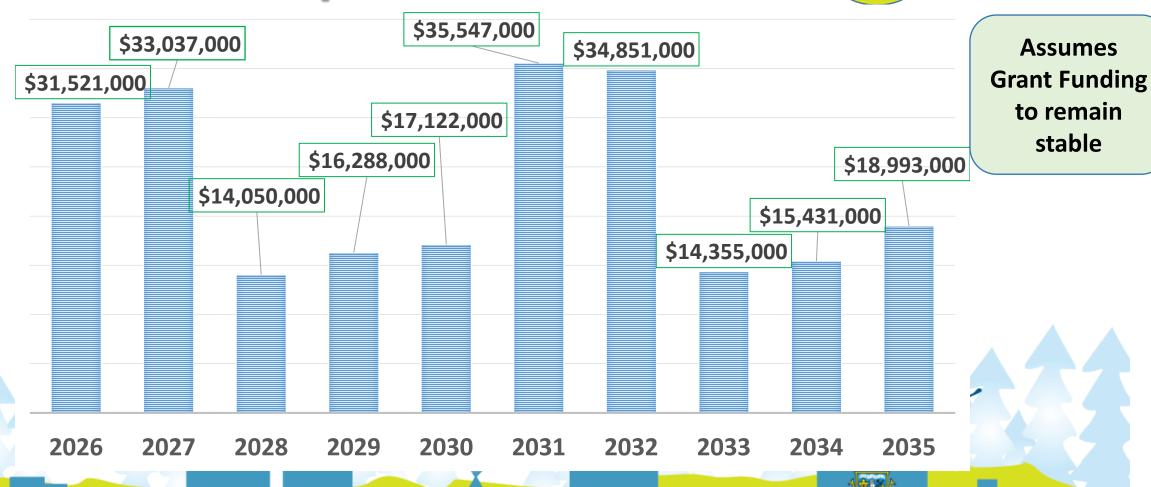

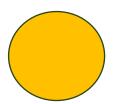
