Proclamation



RIDE TO WORK DAY

JUNE 19, 2017

BE IT KNOWN to whom these presents do concern;

WHEREAS, scooters and motorcycles have a less harmful impact on our infrastructure and environment; and

WHEREAS, scooters and motorcycles require only a fraction of space taken by other vehicles to park, thereby addressing an ongoing parking shortage; and

WHEREAS, the direct and indirect costs of fossil fuels are all continually increasing; and

WHEREAS, our road and infrastructure repairs fail to keep up with wear and degradation; and

WHEREAS, for these reasons, scooters and motorcycles offer a form of daily transportation to be encouraged; and

WHEREAS, June 19, 2017 has been designated as "Ride To Work Day" to highlight the positive daily use of scooters and motorcycles.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Mark Heyck, Mayor of the City of Yellowknife, by the power vested in me do hereby proclaim June 19, 2017 as Ride To Work Day in the City of Yellowknife.
