


The wild doesn't end where the roads begin

From the still-in-use shacks in the Woodyard (near Ragged Ass Road and Bretzlaff Drive) to the Wildcat Cafe and Yellowknife's oldest general store, Weaver and Devore, the city's history is still alive and well.


