SEPTEMBER 8 & 9, 2025 FRANKLIN AVENUE AND 52 STREET INTERSECTION PARTIAL CLOSURE, FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL REPLACEMENT



The City of Yellowknife will be undertaking the replacement of Traffic Signals at Franklin and 52 Street.

The work will include the replacement of signal poles and intersection street lights.

Intersection Closure:
Sunday September 7, 2025
Due to the overhead work, while the poles are erected the intersection will be closed.

Intersection partial Closure:
September 8 and 9, 2025
Work is expected to continue until complete.
Once the poles are safely erected electrical work is expected to last 2 days. During this time 52 Street will be closed to through traffic both sides of Franklin. Franklin Avenue will be reduced to single lane through traffic, no left or right turns will be permitted at the intersection.

All road users are asked to use caution, reduce speed, and obey all traffic signage and directions from traffic control personnel.

Although construction may cause short-term disruptions, it is essential for keeping the City's infrastructure safe, functional, and up to date.
