# SNOW REMOVAL SCHEDULE

#### Monday, December 25 and Tuesday, December 26, 2023

• The City of Yellowknife would like to advise residents that due to the statutory holiday, there will be no snow removal on December 25 and 26, 2023.

#### Wednesday, December 27, 2023

- Byrne Road from Woolgar Avenue to McMahon Trail;
- Taylor Road from Forrest Drive to Sissons Court; and
- Norseman Drive from Franklin Avenue to Old Airport Road.

### Thursday, December 28, 2023

- Morrison Drive from Sikyea Tili to Otto Drive South;
- 54 Street from Con Road to End; and
- Finlayson Drive from Banke Crescent to Dagenais Drive.

### Friday, December 29, 2023

- Woolgar Avenue from Kam Lake Road to Range Lake road; and
- Magrum Crescent from Borden Drive to Piro Court.

Residents must ensure parked vehicles are removed from these streets by midnight, or they will be towed. Residents are advised that there will be traffic delays in snow removal areas and if possible, to use an alternate route to avoid delays. The City asks residents to ensure Curbside Carts are returned to their property before the scheduled snow removal on their street. Thank you for your patience, and remember to use caution in snow removal areas and not to pass moving equipment.

Water Delivery that would normally take place on Christmas and on New year's day will instead take place on **December 24 and 31, 2023**.

#### **Christmas Trees**

Christmas Trees will be accepted at the Solid Waste Facility free of charge during the month of January.

#### Public Transit

There will be no Transit and YATS Service on **December 25, 2023**, **December 26, 2023** and **January 1, 2024** due to Statutory Holidays. Afternoon Express buses will be cancelled on **December 21 and 22, 2023**. All Express buses will be cancelled from **December 27, 2023** through to **January 3, 2024**. ### **REINSTATING PENALTIES FOR TAXES AND UTILITIES**

Penalties will be applied at a rate of 1.8% on all overdue balances on the first day of each calendar month, until overdue amounts are paid in full. Any overdue utility charges as of **December 31, 2023**, will be transferred to property owners' tax accounts.
