Thank you for your patience, and remember to use caution in snow removal areas and not to pass moving equipment.

## **Snow Removal Reminders**

The City of Yellowknife wishes to remind property owners that snow from public sidewalks next to your property may be placed but not piled on the road. Snow from your driveway or any other portion of your property may not be placed on the road. Placing unauthorized snow on the road greatly increases snow volumes and creates unsafe driving conditions. Snow from your driveway or any other portion of your property must be placed elsewhere on your property. #### WINTER TRAFFIC SAFETY TIPS

The City of Yellowknife wants to remind drivers of a few winter driving safety requirements:

- Always clear excess snow from your vehicle and windshield. Excess snow can obstruct the view of the driver or fly off and land on other cars creating hazards for drivers;
- Ensure your windows are fully defrosted before driving. Driving without adequate view can result in a \$100 penalty;
- During reduced visibility, turn on your headlights! This also turns on your taillights which allows drivers to see you from behind during ice fog and snow; and
- Drive to the conditions. Snow and ice reduce traction, which means you require more stopping distance. Follow at a safe distance and reduce your speed.

Drive safe. Plan your ride and arrive alive, don't drink and drive!

# **FIRE SAFETY & EDUCATION**

### **Fire Hydrant Access**

If the Yellowknife Fire Division is delayed in obtaining a water supply to fight a fire, we may lose control of the fire. Keep hydrants clear of snow for uninterrupted water supply giving the best opportunity of a successful outcome. If you are unable to clear the snow yourself, please contact the City at 920-5600 to advise the location of the hydrant that requires clearing.

#### **Propane**

If you use a propane furnace, stove or other appliance in your home be sure to install a propane gas detector. If you detect a leak at any time, get everyone out of your house. Shut off the gas and call your propane supplier. It's very important for a certified technician to determine that all propane-powered devices are leak free.
