The City asks residents to ensure Curbside Carts are returned to their property before the scheduled snow removal on their street. Thank you for your patience, and remember to use caution in snow removal areas and not to pass moving equipment.

Downtown Alleys

The City of Yellowknife will be performing snow removal activities in the downtown alleys between 54 Street and 43 Street and from Franklin Avenue to 49 Avenue the week of March 27 to 31, 2023. There will be no signage posted 24 hours in advance prior to snow removal. Please have vehicles and garbage receptacles removed from these areas. The City thanks you for your patience and reminds residents to use caution in snow removal areas and to not pass moving equipment.

Snow Removal Reminders

The City of Yellowknife wishes to remind property owners that snow from public sidewalks next to your property may be placed but not piled on the road. Snow from your driveway or any other portion of your property **may not be placed on the road**. Placing unauthorized snow on the road greatly increases snow volumes and creates unsafe driving conditions. For contractors, the SWF will reopen on **Monday, March 27, 2023**, for regular hours.

Please note the SWF will be closed on Friday, April 7, 2023; Sunday, April 9; and Monday, April 10, 2023, for the Easter weekend. It will be open for regular hours on Saturday, April 8, 2023.

Blue Bin Recycling stations are being reestablished starting today and throughout the coming week, as staffing allows.

A reminder to all residents that garbage pick-up will continue the week of March 27, 2023. Organics pick-up (green carts) will begin the week of April 3, 2023. 
