The City of Yellowknife would like to inform residents that parts of 49 Street, Franklin Avenue, Veterans Memorial Drive, 53 Street and 51 Avenue will be closed to vehicle traffic and parking from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 11, 2023 for Remembrance Day Ceremonies.

Snow Shoveling

Snow from public sidewalks abutting your property may be placed on the road, however, snow from your driveway or any other portion of your property cannot. Placing unauthorized snow on the road greatly increases snow volumes, and therefore creates unsafe driving conditions. This snow must be placed on your own property.

Trucked Service Access

The City would like to remind properties on trucked water and sewer to keep access to their service connection points clear of snow and ice. If the connection points are not accessible water delivery and/or sewage pumpout may not occur until access problems have been fixed.
