Waste Disposal

Regular bi-weekly rotating schedule will resume (garbage the week of **October 9, 2023,** organics the week of **October 16, 2023**, etc.).

Grass Clippings and Leaves

Leaves, grass clippings, and small brush can be brought to the Solid Waste Facility and disposed of free of charge when placed in a paper bag. However, when this waste comes to the SWF in plastic and other non-compostable bags, it is considered residential garbage and is subject to the associated charges.

Let's work together to divert as much waste as possible from the landfill by ensuring that no plastic is mixed with leaf and yard waste. Learn more about the City's composting program at www.yellowknife.ca/composting.

Animal Waste

The City of Yellowknife reminds residents not to place animal waste in their green cart. Animal waste should be taken to the Solid Waste Facility (SWF), free of charge, and placed in the yellow Animal Waste bin for safe disposal.

The SWF is open to the public from **11:00** a.m. to **4:15** p.m., Tuesday to Sunday, closed to the public on Mondays.

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

From **October 8 to 14, 2023,** the Yellowknife Fire Division is promoting cooking safety as part of this year's edition of Fire Prevention Week. Here are a few useful tips:

- Watch what you heat. Always keep a close eye on what you are cooking;
- Turn pot handles toward the back of the stove and always keep a lid nearby when cooking. If a small grease fire starts, slide the lid over the pan and turn off the burner; and
- Have a "kid- and pet-free zone" of at least 1 meter around the stove or grill and anywhere else hot food or drink is prepared or carried
