## LSS Bronze Medallion

The Bronze Medallion Award teaches an understanding of the lifesaving principles embodied in the four components of water rescue education - judgment, knowledge, skill and fitness. Rescuers learn tows and carries, and defense and release methods in preparation for rescues of increased risk involving conscious and unconscious victims of various types. Lifesavers develop stroke efficiency and endurance in a timed swim. Prerequisites - Ability to swim a few strokes with good endurance for a distance of 500 meters and 13 years of age OR Bronze Star Award. This program runs from March 4 to 8, 2024.

### **Bronze Cross & Lifesaving CPR'C**

Bronze Cross is designed for lifesavers who want the challenge of more advanced training including an introduction to safe supervision in aquatic facilities. Bronze Cross is a prerequisite for all advanced training programs including the National Lifeguard certification. Prerequisite - Bronze Medallion Award. This program runs from March 11 to 15, 2024.

- Ensure it has a ULC or CSA label which shows it is tested to Canadian standards.
