

**CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE
BY-LAW NO. 3899**

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories, repeal and replace By-law No. 146, a by-law naming certain roadways within the municipality.

PURSUANT TO SECTION 70(d) of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c. C-8.

WHEREAS it is deemed to be in the public interest to number municipal roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular session duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

1. That municipal roads identified on Schedule A shall bear the names shown in Schedule A, attached to and forming part of this by-law.


REPEAL

2. That By-law No. 146 is hereby repealed.

3. This By-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 57 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.
