

**CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE
BY-LAW NO. 4702**

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, authorizing the City of Yellowknife to amend By-law No. 4644 by replacing Schedule A contained therein with legal description.

PURSUANT to Section 53 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22;

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife has enacted By-law No. 4644;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife is desirous of amending By-law No. 4644;

AND WHEREAS Council supports the development of Block 501, pursuant to all municipal, federal and territorial legislation;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular session duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

1. THAT By-law No. 4644 is hereby amended by:
 - 1) Replacing "By-law No. 4583" with "By-law No. 4702" in the preamble.
 - 2) Deleting Schedule A and replacing it with legal description.
 - a. Deleting all references to "a portion of Lot 5, Block 501" or "a portion of Block 501" and replacing them with "Lot 8, Block 501, Plan 4426".
 - b. Deleting Schedule A and amending Section 1 as follows:



That the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife is hereby authorized to dispose of fee simple title in that parcel of land more particularly described as:

Lot 8, Block 501, Plan 4426
Yellowknife



EFFECT

3. THIS by-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 75 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.


