

**CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE
BY-LAW NO. 4558**

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife to amend By-law No. 4420, being a by-law authorizing the City to acquire, from T.C. Enterprises Ltd., a freehold interest in land for the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, in the Northwest Territories.

PURSUANT to Sections 53 and 73 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22;

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife has enacted By-law No. 4420;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife is desirous of amending By-law No. 4420 by amending the legal descriptors provided therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular session duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

1. That By-law No 4420 is hereby amended as follows:

Under 1. APPLICATION, deleting the following reference:

All that portion of Lot 4, Block 92, as shown on a Plan of Survey signed by the Deputy Surveyor General North, under Item No. 2006-18-055, Yellowknife, lying within Lot 768-2, Group 964, Plan 1169, Yellowknife;


and replacing therewith:

All that portion of Lot 3, Block 92, Plan 1769, lying within Road R32 Weledeh, as shown on a Plan of Survey reviewed by the Deputy Surveyor General North under Item No. 2006-18-055.

EFFECT


2. THIS by-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 75 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.


