

**CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE
BY-LAW NO. 4388**

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife authorizing the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife to repeal By-law Nos. 4366 and 4384 and to dispose a freehold interest in land for the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, in the Northwest Territories.

PURSUANT to Section 54 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22;

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife has enacted By-law No. 4366 and By-law No. 4384;

AND WHEREAS the said parcels of land are not required for not required for municipal purposes;

AND WHEREAS the said parcels of land are available for disposal by the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

1. That the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife is hereby authorized to dispose of a freehold interest in the following parcels of land:

2. THAT the Mayor and City Administrator of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, or lawful deputy of either of them, are hereby authorized in the name and on the behalf of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, to execute all such forms of application, deeds, indentures, and other documents as may be necessary to give effect to this By-law and to affix thereto the corporate seal of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife as the act and deed thereof, subscribing their names in attestation of such execution.


REPEALS






