

**CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE
BY-LAW NO. 4356**

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories, to officially open and name a municipal roadway within the City of Yellowknife.

PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 86 and 88 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T. 2003, c. 22.

WHEREAS Council has deemed it desirable to name certain roadways in industrial areas within the Municipal Boundaries of the City of Yellowknife after geographically significant locations in the Northwest Territories;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular session duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

1. That the roadway located within portions of Blocks 539 and 540 of the Kam Lake Industrial area, and identified on the sketch attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, be officially renamed:

Drybones Drive after Drybones Bay which is situated on the Great Slave Lake, approximately 56 km from Yellowknife.

EFFECT


2. This By-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 75 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.
