

**CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE  
BY-LAW NO. 4555**

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife to amend By-law No. 4525, being a by-law authorizing the City to acquire Title in Fee Simple in land for the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, in the Northwest Territories.

PURSUANT to Sections 53 and 73 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22;

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife has enacted By-law No. 4525;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife is desirous of amending By-law No. 4525 by correcting a clerical error contained therein, and by amending the legal descriptors provided in Schedule "A" thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular session duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

**APPLICATION**

1. That By-law No 4525 is hereby amended as follows:

Under Application, 1.

Deleting all existing text and replacing therewith:

"THAT the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife is hereby authorized to acquire Title in Fee Simple more particularly described as:

Lot 32, Block 27,  
as shown on a Plan of Survey reviewed by the Canada Centre for Cadastral Management under Item #200918115."

**EFFECT**


2. THIS by-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 75 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.




