

**CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE
BY-LAW NO. 4345**

A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories to authorize the establishment, levy and collection of charges for solid waste management;

PURSUANT TO Section 58 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T. 2003, c. C-22.

WHEREAS the City of Yellowknife wishes to raise revenue to offset the costs of its solid waste collection and disposal operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

This By-law may be referred to as the Solid Waste Levy By-law.

DEFINITION

premises - each single family residential dwelling shall be considered to be one premise. For multi-premise and non-residential properties, the number of premises shall be established as follows:

-	apartments	one premise per suite
-	schools	one premise per 10 children
-	hostels	one premise per 5 residents
-	offices	one premise per 1000 sq. ft.
-	businesses	one premise per 1000 sq. ft.
-	hospitals	one premise per bed
-	hotels/motels	one premise per 2 rooms
-	churches	one premise per water meter

APPLICATION

1. The municipal corporation of the City of Yellowknife is authorized to levy a charge of eleven (\$11.00) dollars per month on all premises in the City of Yellowknife.
2. The charge will be levied at the same time as the monthly charge for water services provided by the City.


REPEAL

EFFECT




