

CITY OF YELLOWKNIFEBY-LAW No. 2160

Being a by-law to dispose of a dangerous animal,

PURSUANT TO Section 174 of the Municipal Ordinance, being Chapter M-15 of the Revised Ordinances of the Northwest Territories 1974 as amended.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Yellowknife may pass by-laws requiring the removal of anything deemed dangerous to the safety of the inhabitants and preventing and abating nuisances generally,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Yellowknife deems the keeping in captivity within the boundaries of the City of a lion to be a nuisance and a danger to the safety of the inhabitants of the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular meeting duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall keep or harbour a lion within the City of Yellowknife on or after the Fifteenth day of September in the year 1977.
2. Any lion found within the City of Yellowknife on or after the Fifteenth day of September in the year 1977 shall be liable to be destroyed forthwith.


