

**CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE
BY-LAW NO. 4508**

A By-law of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife being a by-law to amend the legal description in By-law No. 4496, a by-law to dispose of a freehold interest in land for the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, in the Northwest Territories.

PURSUANT to Sections 54 and 73 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T., 2003, c. 22;

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife has enacted By-law No. 4496;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife is desirous of amending By-law No. 4496;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

1. That By-law No. 4496 is hereby amended by deleting the legal description therein and replacing therewith:


Lot 3
Block 110,
As shown on a plan of survey reviewed by the
Canada Centre for Cadastral Management under
File # SM8492-Y1.

2. THAT the Mayor and City Administrator of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, or lawful deputy of either of them, are hereby authorized in the name and on the behalf of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, to execute all such forms of application, deeds, indentures, and other documents as may be necessary to give effect to this by-law and to affix thereto the corporate seal of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife as the act and deed thereof, subscribing their names in attestation of such execution.

EFFECT

3. THIS By-law shall come into effect upon receiving Third Reading and otherwise meets the requirements of Section 75 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*.


