

CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE  
BY-LAW NO. 4307

A BY-LAW of the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife, in the Northwest Territories, providing for the employment and conditions of employment for permanent employees of the Municipal Enforcement Division, excluding clerical staff and the Manager of Municipal Enforcement;

PURSUANT TO Section 51 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, R.S.N.W.T., 1988, c. C-8.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, in regular session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This By-law may be cited as the "Municipal Enforcement Division Personnel Employment By-law (2004/06)".

AUTHORIZATION

2. The Mayor and Senior Administrative Officer are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Yellowknife, the Agreement referred to as Schedule "A" annexed hereto and forming part of this By-law.

REPEAL

3. By-law No. 4112 is hereby repealed.

EFFECT

4. The provisions of this By-law shall be effective from the 1st day of January, 2004.
