

CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE
BY-LAW NO. 4354

A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Yellowknife in the Northwest Territories to amend Public Transit By-law No. 4284;

PURSUANT TO Section 58 of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S.N.W.T. 2003, c. 22.

WHEREAS the City of Yellowknife wishes to raise revenue to offset the costs of its public transit service.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF YELLOWKNIFE, at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

APPLICATION

1. By-law No. 4284 is hereby amended by deleted Schedule "A" and replacing it with Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.

EFFECT





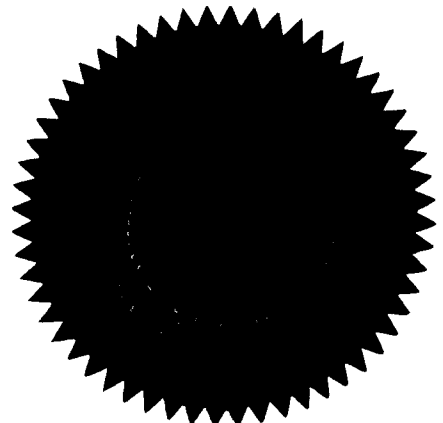

SCHEDULE "A"

TRANSIT FARES

Adults	\$2.50 per ride
Students*, Seniors** and Disabled People**	\$1.50 per ride
Children 5 years old or younger (when accompanied by a fare-paying rider)	Free
Adult Monthly Pass (unlimited rides)	\$62
Aurora College Students and Elementary Students with a Student Bus Pass Monthly Pass	\$40
Seniors** and Disabled People** Monthly Pass (unlimited rides)	\$40
Adult Punch Pass (11 rides for price of 10)	\$25
Seniors** and Disabled People** Punch Pass (11 rides for 10)	\$15
Summer Monthly Pass (all riders 6 and older)	\$40

(passes are not transferable to other riders)

* Students 6 years of age or over attending primary or secondary school up to 18 years of age.

** Seniors are 65 years of age or older. Seniors and the Disabled may be required to produce identification.
